- SIGHTS:** Seniors – Any Sights; Juniors - Iron Sights
(if you are an advanced junior, come with your scope in case if you are promoted to the senior category)
- AMMUNITION:** All teams will use only the standard velocity .22 caliber rim-fire ammunition provided by match sponsors
- CLASSIFICATION:** Unclassified Match
- ENTRIES:** Entries will be made using SR1 Card or call Blue Trail. Entries limited to one hundred (100) competitors. Make checks payable to Blue Trail and mail to Blue Trail Range, 316 N. Branford Rd, Wallingford, CT, 06492
- FEES:** SENIORS - \$26; JUNIORS- \$24
- TEAM MAKE-UP:** All Seniors will draw a junior entry for his partner. Two relays will be run; Coaching is allowed.
- SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded after team drawing. Confirmation of entries will not be sent unless requested.
- COURSE OF FIRE:** 40 Shots at 50 Yards (Target: A23/5) and 40 Shots at 100 Yards (Target: A25)
- AWARDS:** Winning Team; Miniature John K. Lee Trophies and Name on Permanent Trophy
2nd & 3rd Place Teams: Olympic-type John K. Lee Medals
Each 5th Place Team: John K. Lee Medals

RULES: NRA APPROVED MATCH. Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules

CLASSIFICATION: NRA Classification system will be used. Individuals that are unclassified will fire in their own class for 1st place award ONLY. Rule 19.6 may be used.

ENTRIES: Entries will be made using the enclosed registration card. Entries limited to 120 competitors. Make checks payable to Blue Trail Range and mail to Blue Trail Range, 316 N. Branford Rd, Wallingford, CT, 06492

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Entry confirmations will not be sent unless requested.

MATCHES: Match #1: 40 shots at 50 yards (A23/5) Metallic sights
Match #2: 40 shots at 50 meters (A26) Metallic sights
Match #3: 40 shots at Dewar course (A23/5 & A25) Any sights
Match #4: 40 shots at 100 yards (A25) Any sights
Match #5: Iron sight aggregate (Unfired- match #1 and #2)
Match #6: Any sight aggregate (Unfired- match #3 and #4)
Match #7: John K. Lee Championship (Unfired- match #1,2,3,4)

AWARDS: Open winner of each match. Class winner if more than 5 competitors in each class; 2nd Place (10 competitors); 3rd Place (20 competitors), etc. Special awards given in match #7 only [High Junior, High Intermediate Junior, High Sub-Junior, High collegiate, High Service (must have 5 competitors in each category for award)]. These awards take precedence over class awards. Class awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor. 60% of match fees will be returned to competitors in awards. Choice of award points or trophies.

NOTE #1: **Bring your own clips to hang targets (14 minimum).**

NOTE #2: **Competitors will hang and retrieve their own targets.**

NOTE #3: **This match is designed to be a fun weekend for all.** There are various sights to see and restaurants minutes from the range. For hotel accommodations, call the Sheraton Four Points at 203-238-2380 (five miles from range). Be sure to mention the Blue Trail Range rate.
