Welcome! Last year, we celebrated the 89th Anniversary of this prestigious match. This year we celebrate the 90th Anniversary! This match proves that the shooting sports are for all ages as the participation age will range from 9 to 90. Awards are based on the Lewis Class system. Merit Medals will be awarded to all competitors firing in the Sub-Junior and Junior portions of the match regardless of their fired score immediately after firing the match—Gold for Juniors & Silver for Sub-Juniors. Remember that a Sub-Junior can shoot in the Junior and Senior matches as well (chance for more awards and a Junior Merit Medal!) and the Junior can shoot in the Senior match. Sponsorship of the medals is partially donated by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Let’s ring in the 90th Anniversary of this Match and adopt some “Gallery Match” fever--send your entry in today, bring a friend—this match is open to everyone (from “first-time” shooters to “over-the-hill” shooters), and be a participant in the 90th Gallery Match. Without your attendance, the match will not be a success.

This year’s match will be fired again on the Orion scoring system-- the only scoring system in the world that includes online results. Rules: **NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules** will govern. No pick-up teams allowed.

Time limit: **Seniors/Juniors:** 33 Minutes. Each competitor will fire 5 record shots for each position ONLY on each target. Competitor choice to hang 2 or 1 target at a time.
Sub-Juniors: 33 Minutes. Each competitor will fire 10 record shots ONLY on each target. Competitor choice to hang 2 or 1 target at a time.

Scoring: Orion System will be used.

Course of Fire:

Sub-Juniors: 20 Shots Prone, Iron Sights (coaching allowed)
Juniors: 5 shots each Prone, Sitting, Kneeling & Standing Iron Sights (coaching allowed)
Seniors: 5 shots each Prone, Sitting, Kneeling & Standing Any Sights (no coaching allowed)
Reminder that Sub-Juniors can fire in the Junior and Senior Matches, and Juniors can fire in the Senior Match; allows for additional chances for individual and team awards. Backers MUST be used.

Relay Times:

Every 45 minutes on dates posted on 1st page of program.

(additional date and/or relays will be added at the discretion of the match director if entries warrant)

\$20.00 per match. **Make checks payable to CSRRA.**

SR Ind & Team: Match Winner and Hi Out-of-State or Hi CT, Hi Woman, Hi CT Senior (55+).
JR Ind & Team: Match Winner and Hi Out-of-State or Hi CT, Hi High School, Hi Prep, Hi Girl.
SJ Ind & Team: Match Winner and Hi Out-of-State or Hi CT, Hi Girl.

Lewis Class System for every 5th Place in all individual and team matches, including 89th Place.
Can only win one special award in each match.
